1. Language

The Contract as well as all correspondence and documents relating to the Contract exchanged by the Supplier and KASNEB , shall be written in the English Language.

2. Eligibility

The goods shall have the nationality of an eligible country. All Goods and Related Services to be supplied under the Contract shall have their origin in Eligible Countries.

3. Notices

Any notice given by one party to the other pursuant to the Contract shall be in writing.

4. Governing Law

The Contract shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the Laws of Kenya, unless otherwise specified hereunder.

5. Settlement of Disputes

kasneb and the Supplier shall make every effort to resolve amicably by direct informal negotiation any disagreement or dispute arising between them under or in connection with the Contract. If the parties have failed to resolve their dispute or difference by such mutual consultation, either kasneb or the Supplier may give notice to the other party of its intention to commence arbitration. The dispute shall be referred to adjudication or arbitration in accordance with the laws of Kenya.

6. Supplier/Contractor/Service Provider Responsibilities

The Supplier shall supply all the Goods included in the Schedule of Requirements.

7. Contract Price

Prices charged by the Supplier under the Contract shall not vary from the prices quoted by the Supplier in its quotation.

8. Terms of Payment

The Contract Price shall be paid One hundred (100) percent upon submission of an invoice supported by the acceptance certificate issued by KASNEB, after satisfactory demonstration and delivery of all 80 units.

9. Inspections and Tests

The Supplier shall at its own expense carry out all such tests and/or inspections of the Goods to confirm their conformity to technical specifications. A mandatory on-site demonstration of detection capability is required at handover.

10. Warranty

The Supplier warrants that all the Goods are new, unused, and of the most recent or current models. Minimum warranty period is 12 months from date of delivery and acceptance.
